Capital Campaign Update

Have you submitted your family's pledge to the "God's House, Our Home" capital campaign?

A BIG thanks to those of you who have and a friendly request for those of you who have not to please do so by the campaign deadline of March 31.

We need every member household to contribute, as they are able, to



this campaign. As a reminder, the goal of this \$300,000 campaign is for FLC to stay debt free over the next 10-15 years by raising needed funds for the Property Fund.

The Property Board looked ahead 15 years and estimated major replacements and upgrades needed at both our church building and the parsonage. You can find that list in the mailing sent out at the end of January.

Some of you are financially able to write a check for \$5,000, \$10,000 or more. We will need several gifts of this size to meet our needed goal. For many of us, a gift of that size is simply not possible, but perhaps you can give \$50, \$100, or \$200 per month over the 3-year term of the campaign.

What is needed is that each member household take an honest, prayerful look at their finances and to give as generously as you are able. TOGETHER we will practice generous, joyful giving and set our church up for financial health in the years to come.
